**劳森•杨格博士**(谢菲尔德大学哲学博士)是美国伊利诺伊州迪尔菲尔德市三一国际大学的三一福音神学院的旧约、闪语、古近东史教授。

杨格博士是知名的传道人及解经学者。他在三一教授许多课程,其中包括为教牧学博士生开设的"士师记教导讲道"。他是《国际应用释经系列》(NIV Application Commentary series)中士师记与路得记注释的作者。此外,他还发表了许多希伯来圣经及背景方面的重要著作,如《古代征服记事:古代近东与圣经历史文献研究》(Ancient Conquest Accounts: A Study of Ancient Near Eastern and Biblical History Writing, 1990),三卷本的《圣经背景》(The Context of Scripture. 3 Volumes, 1997—2002),《比较正典》(The Canon in Comparative Perspective, 1991)等。他正在撰写一部亚兰史著作。

杨格博士是亚述学和亚兰文专家,对于希伯来圣经也很精通。他是美国大学东方研究会(American Schools of Oriental Research)的理事,美国东方学会(American Oriental Society)、国际亚述学协会(International Association of Assyriology)及圣经文学献会(Society of Biblical Literature)的活跃成员。杨格博士亦荣任:

**Dr. K. Lawson Younger, Jr.** (Ph.D. Sheffield) is Professor of Old Testament, Semitic Languages, and Ancient Near Eastern History at Trinity Evangelical Divinity School of Trinity International University, Deerfield, Illinois.

Dr. Younger is a noted preacher and Bible expounder. His teaching responsibilities at Trinity include a course for D. Min. students on the Teaching and Preaching of Judges. He is the author of the commentary on Judges and Ruth in the NIV Application Commentary series. In addition he has published a number of significant works on the Hebrew Bible and its background, including *Ancient Conquest Accounts: A Study of Ancient Near Eastern and Biblical History Writing* (1990), *The Context of Scripture. 3 Volumes* (1997-2002); *The Canon in Comparative Perspective* (1991). He is presently working on a book on the history of the Arameans.

He is a specialist in Assyriology and Aramaic, as well as the Hebrew Bible. He is a trustee of the American Schools of Oriental Research, as well as an active member of the American Oriental Society, the International Association of Assyriology, and the Society of Biblical Literature.
