Scott Manetsch is Professor of Church History and the History of Christian Thought at Trinity Evangelical Divinity School, where he has served since 2000. His research interests include the Protestant Reformation, Calvin and Calvinism, the history of the pastoral office, and early modern biblical interpretation. Dr. Manetsch has authored or edited a number of books, including *Theodore Beza and the Quest for Peace in France* (Brill, 2000), *The Great Commission* (with Martin Klauber; B & H, 2008), *Calvin's Company of Pastors* (Oxford, 2013), and the *Reformation Commentary on Scripture: 1 Corinthians* (InterVarsity, 2017). He is also the associate general editor of the Reformation Commentary on Scripture (InterVarsity Press) and the editor-secretary of the Christ on Campus Initiative (see christoncampuscci.org).
