

川珀・朗曼三世博士(Tremper Longman III, PhD.)

朗曼博士是韦斯特蒙特学院的圣经研究教授。他在俄亥俄卫斯理大学获得宗教学的学士(B.A.),在西敏斯神学院获道学硕士(M.Div),在耶鲁大学获古近东研究博士学位(Ph.D)。

朗曼博士所著及参与写作的书超过二十本,亦有大量专文发表。他的许多著述是跨学科的。Literary Approaches to Biblical Interpretation (Zondervan, 1987)、Complete Literary

Guide to the Bible (撰文并与 Leland Ryken 一同编辑; Zondervan, 1993)和许多文章都从文学鉴别角度进行圣经研究。

他也与心理学家 Dan Allender 一起撰写了许多书 (Bold Love [NavPress, 1991]; Cry of the Soul [NavPress, 1994], Intimate Allies [Tyndale House Publishers, 1995], Bold Purpose (Tyndale House Publishers, 1997]); 一个名为 The Intimate Mystery of Marriage (InterVarsity Press, 2005) 的教会课程; 以及最近的书 Breaking the Idols of Your Heart: How to Navigate the Temptations of Life (IVP, 2007)。

他对于历史和历史学的兴趣在 A Biblical History of Israel [与 Iain Provan 和 Phil Long 合著; Westminster John Knox, 2003] 中有所表达。他也写过许多解经书,包括雅歌(Eerdmans)、传道书(Eerdmans)、但以理书(Zondervan)、那鸿书(Baker)、箴言(Baker)、耶利米书和耶利米哀歌(Hendrickson),和约伯记(Baker)注释。出版机构 InterVarsity Press 出了他的四本书: How to Read Psalms, How to Read Proverbs, How to Read Genesis, and How to Read Exodus,还有他参与编辑并有撰文的 The Dictionary of the Old Testament: Wisdom, Poetry and Writings (IVP)。此外,他还是英文圣经新普及译本(New Living Translation)的主要译者之一,并担任其他一些常见英文译本(the Message, the New Century Version, and the Holman Standard Bible)的顾问。他最近出版了 The Expanded Bible: New Testament (与 Mark Strauss 和 Dan Taylor 合著),新一代的扩展版圣经。

Tremper Longman III, PhD.

Dr. Tremper Longman III is the Robert H. Gundry Professor of Biblical Studies at Westmont College. He earned a B.A. in Religion at Ohio Wesleyan University, an M.Div. from Westminster Theological Seminary, and a Ph.D. in ancient Near Eastern studies from Yale University.

Tremper has authored or co-authored over twenty books and written numerous articles. A number of these works are

interdisciplinary. His <u>Literary Approaches to Biblical Interpretation (Zondervan, 1987)</u>; <u>Complete Literary Guide to the Bible</u> (contributor and co-editor along with <u>Leland Ryken; Zondervan, 1993)</u> and numerous articles approach the study of the Bible through literary criticism.

He also co-authors books with the psychologist Dan Allender (<u>Bold Love [NavPress, 1991]</u>; Cry of the Soul [NavPress, 1994], <u>Intimate Allies [Tyndale House Publishers, 1995]</u>, <u>Bold Purpose (Tyndale House Publishers, 1997]</u>), a church curriculum called <u>The Intimate Mystery of Marriage (InterVarsity Press, 2005)</u>, and most recently <u>Breaking the Idols of Your Heart: How to Navigate the Temptations of Life (IVP, 2007)</u>.

His interest in history and historiography is expressed in <u>A Biblical History of Israel</u> [co-authored with Iain Provan and Phil Long; Westminster John Knox, 2003]). He has also written commentaries on <u>Song of Songs (Eerdmans)</u>, <u>Ecclesiastes (Eerdmans)</u>, <u>Daniel (Zondervan)</u>, <u>Nahum (Baker)</u>, <u>Proverbs (Baker)</u>, <u>Jeremiah and Lamentations (Hendrickson)</u>, and <u>Job (Baker)</u>. He has written <u>Introducing the Old Testament</u> (<u>Zondervan, 2012</u>) for laypeople as well as a seminary level textbook <u>Introduction to the Old Testament</u> (with R. Dillard, 2nd edition; <u>Zondervan, 2006</u>). For InterVarsity Press, he has produced four books: <u>How to Read Psalms</u>, <u>How to Read Proverbs</u>, and <u>How to Read Genesis</u>, and <u>How to Read Exodus</u>. He co-edited and wrote articles for <u>The Dictionary of the Old Testament</u>: <u>Wisdom</u>, <u>Poetry and Writings (IVP)</u>. In addition, he is one of the main translators of the popular New Living Translation and has served as a consultant on other popular translations of the Bible including the Message, the New Century Version, and the Holman Standard Bible. One of his most recent publication is <u>The Expanded Bible</u>: <u>New Testament</u> (along with Mark Strauss and Dan Taylor), a next generation Amplified Bible.

Tremper and Alice have three sons. For fun, Tremper watches movies to relax and for exercise, he plays squash.
